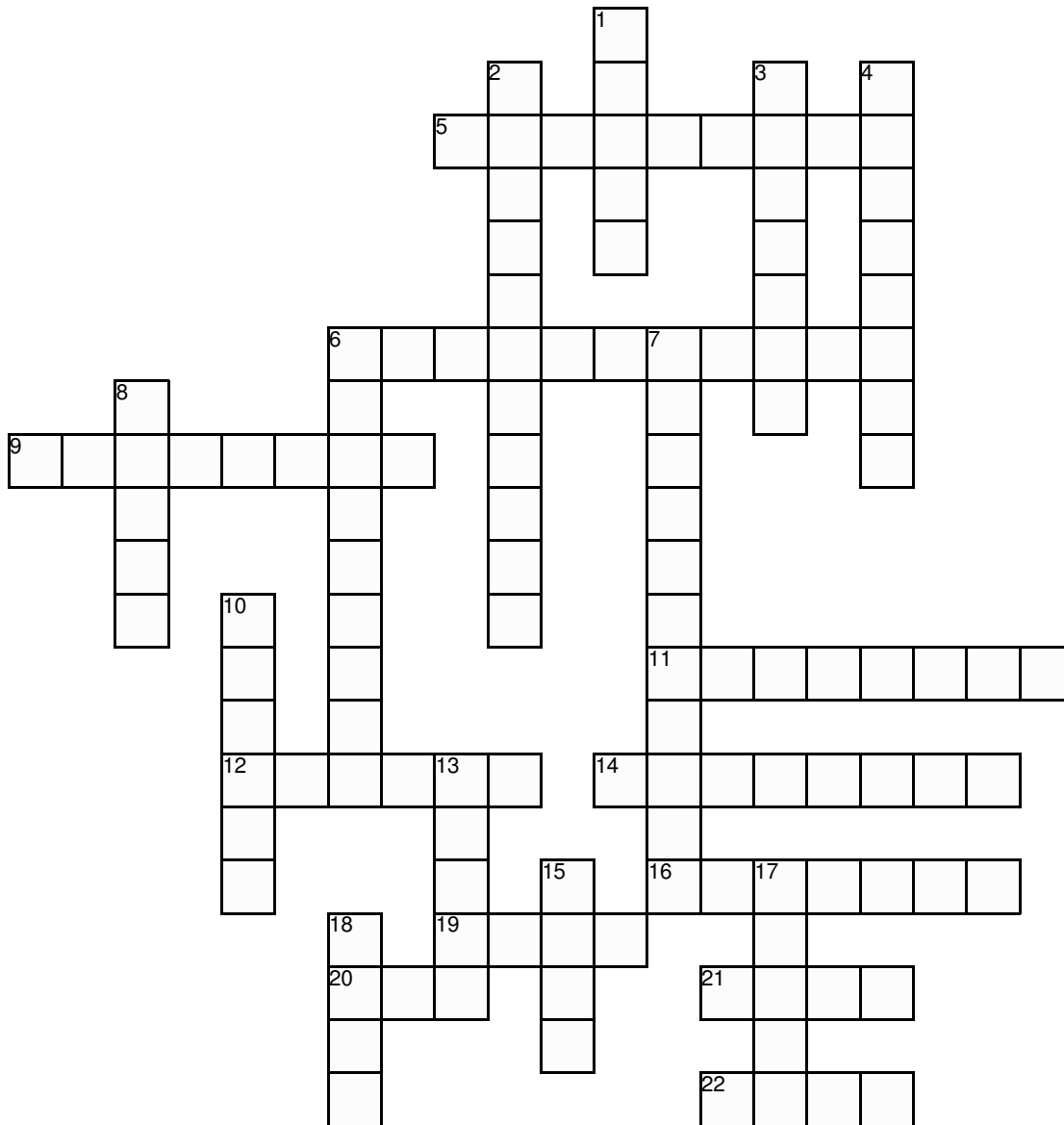


# Day-To-Day Life Aboard Ship
